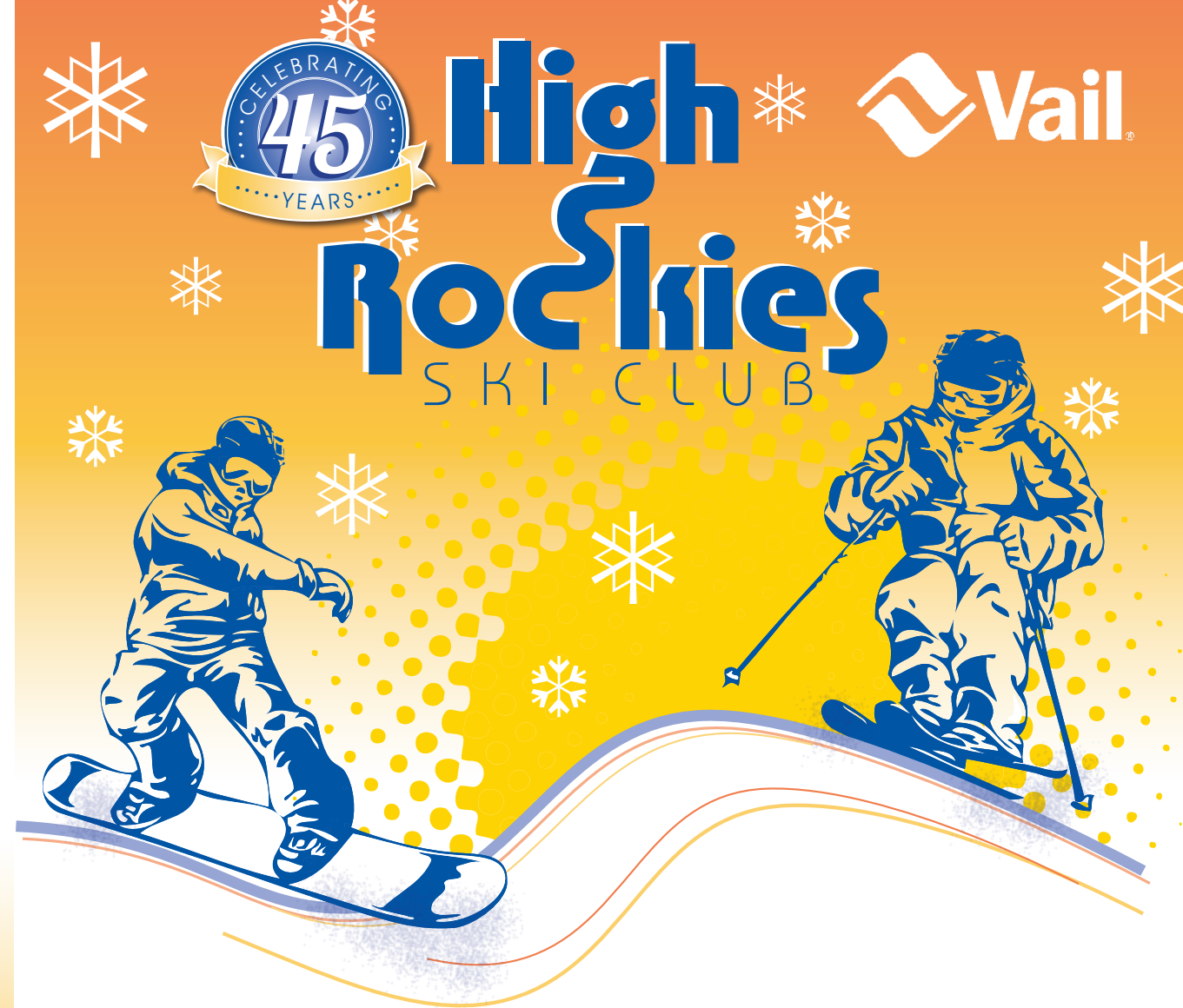

SNOWBOARDING OPEN TO ALL LEVELS

ELITE DOUBLE DIAMOND SKIERS OPEN TO LEVELS 8 AND 9 ONLY

levels

- 1 Green Slow** ➔ First time on skis.
- 2 Green Medium** ➔ Cautious wedge stance on easiest terrain.
- 3 Green Fast** ➔ Round wedge turns on easiest green trails.
- 4 Blue Slow** ➔ Controlled wedge turn with a parallel, skidded finish.
- 5 Blue Medium** ➔ Parallel on easy blue trails using medium size wedge turns.
- 6 Blue Fast** ➔ Blue trails, using a slight wedge with a parallel finish.
- 7 Black Slow** ➔ Parallel on black trails in small bumps and can ski larger bumps with frequent stops.
- 8 Black Medium** ➔ Good technique on all terrain with short carved parallel turns.
- 9 Black Fast** ➔ Extreme skiing. Can make non-stop turns in bumps and powder. Ski the fall line.

*** * PLEASE NOTE: The use of personal cell phones is prohibited during class * ***

CANCELLATIONS & MAKE-UPS

If a cancellation occurs due to uncontrollable conditions (blizzards, exceptional cold, etc.) all bus parents will be notified. Meeting in Vail students should call High Rockies to determine if classes will be held.

TUITION

YOUR TUITION IS NON-REFUNDABLE AFTER DECEMBER 1ST.

High Rockies tuition includes:

- bus transportation - if required
- adult supervision

Balance is due by November 15th.

Your \$200.00 deposit PER CHILD will be refunded, less a \$100.00 service charge, if cancellations are received by December 1st.

An interest-free payment plan is available upon request.

If you have multiple children in the program and one drops out after Dec. 1st, only half of the refund will be applied to another child.

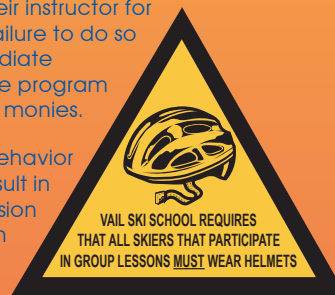
SAFETY RULES

Other Rules:

1. There is no smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or chewing tobacco allowed on the buses or on the mountain by anyone participating in the High Rockies program. Doing so can lead to expulsion from the program with no refund of monies.
2. High Rockies' students are enrolled in a ski class and are expected to remain in their class and with their instructor for the entire day. Failure to do so will lead to immediate expulsion from the program with no refund of monies.
3. Unacceptable behavior on the bus will result in immediate expulsion from the program with no refund of monies.

Release Agreement for Ski Programs & Snowboarding

We understand that High Rockies Ski Club has exercised all reasonable care in selecting their personnel and to avoid accidents. However, we know and appreciate that there are inherent risks and dangers incident to the sport of skiing, ski racing and snowboarding. Recognizing the magnitude of these risks and that the unanticipated and unexpected dangers may arise during such activities, we understand and agree that we and our children assume all of these risks. Furthermore, we and our children hereby release and discharge High Rockies Ski Club, their agents, servants and officers, from all claims, demands and causes of action for any accidents, injuries or loss to either our child or his/her property which may occur as a result of his/her enrollment in and the use of High Rockies Ski Club's facilities.

We understand the High Rockies makes every effort to safeguard the children's belongings and that High Rockies is not responsible for items lost or stolen.

Delayed bus arrival time is still considered a regular ski day. If buses run, it is a scheduled ski day. The cancellation of the buses does not necessarily mean that the program has been cancelled for that day. **If High Rockies is operating, even without the buses, the No Transportation parents are responsible for the transportation of their skiers to Vail.** A "No-Show" will be considered an absence with no refund of monies. High Rockies has sole discretion for any cancellation due to inclement weather.
